Professor R.D. Hinshelwood is an eminent psychiatrist and psychoanalyst. He is a member of the British Psychoanalytic Association and of the Royal College of Psychiatrists.

He is also a Professor at the Centre of Psychoanalytic Studies of the ESSEX University.

Has served as director of the Richmond Cassel Hospital as well as Chair of the Association of Therapeutic Communities.

He has an extensive work as a psychoanalytic writer with several essays on Melanie Klein and other Kleinian psychoanalysts such as "Clinical Klein" and the "Dictionary of Kleinian Thought". He founded the International Journal of Therapeutic Communities (1980) and The British Journal of Psychotherapy (1984).

His application of the psychoanalytic theory and practice in the field of the "difficult patient" and of the psychiatric reality in the public sector is particularly remarkable.

Professor Hinshelwood is a charismatic teacher and this together with his deep psychiatric and psychoanalytic knowledge, which he largely applied in several sectors, confer a particular scientific significance to this conference and will make of it a unique event for Cyprus.
